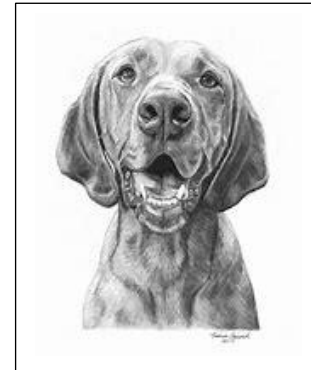

Chapter Section 12. Dogs Eligible to Compete. As used in these regulations, the word “dog” refers to either sex but only to dogs that are eligible for Obedience Regulations entry in AKC events. Dogs with a PAL (Purebred Alternative Listing), ILP (Indefinite Listing Privilege), or AKC Canine Partners number must be spayed or neutered in order to compete.

Section 14. Dogs That May Not Compete. No dog under six months of age may compete. No dog belonging wholly or in part to a judge, or superintendent, or any member of such a person’s household may be entered in any obedience trial at which such person officiates or is scheduled to officiate. Nor may they handle or act as agent for any dog entered at that obedience trial. Females in season are not permitted to compete.

Notice to Exhibitors:

The Trial Secretary is not responsible for emails not received. If you have not received a response to an email after 48 hours, please call or text the Trial Secretary at - (904) 661-8999.

Entry fees will not be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee.

Entry fees will not be refunded if the trials cannot be opened or completed by reason of extreme weather, riots, civil disturbance fire, an act of God, public emergency, an act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

A \$5 fee per dog will be charged for any withdrawal. Entries must be made on Official AKC Entry Forms or copies and must include the signed Agreement & Rules and Jump Height when required. Junior Handlers must complete the back of the entry form. Please include only AKC titles on your entries.

No entry shall be made, and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance. Entries will not be accepted without fees or signatures. No telephone, faxed, or unsigned entries can be accepted and will be returned.

Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, whoever may have made such errors. No entry will be refunded in the event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date.

Errors in entries made by the exhibitor cannot be corrected after the closing date. No refunds for duplicate entries. Post-dated and returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. There is a \$30 returned check fee.

Since bitches in season are not allowed to compete in AKC Obedience/Rally Trials, the club will refund all but \$5.00 for bitches unable to compete for that reason. The Trial Secretary must receive a veterinarian's written notification of such a claim before the first trial date. The safety of the handlers and dogs is our primary concern. By entering these trials, exhibitor acknowledges that they are familiar with the rules and regulations for this sport.

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.

All dogs must be on lead or crated at all times except when in the ring. **We have designated crating areas. NO ex-pens allowed. Bring chairs for seating and be courteous in setting up your area to allow space and passage for other handlers and their dogs.**

All 'warmups" MUST be done ON LEAD. That means the lead is attached to the dog's collar and the handler is holding the lead. **See page 15 for practice ring announcement.**

Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dogs at show site and all hotel, motel, and campgrounds where they are staying while competing in these trials.

Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run. The judge need not wait for any dog holding up a class. K-9 Obedience Club of Jacksonville, Inc. has no obligation or responsibility for providing service through a public address system or steward for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought to the ring when required.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations. State of Florida requires proof of Rabies vaccination if requested.

K-9 Obedience Club of Jacksonville, Inc., their Board, Members, and event volunteers will not be liable for any loss or injury which may be sustained through disappearance, loss, theft, communicable disease, parasites, injury and/or death of dogs entered in this event.

K-9 Obedience Club of Jacksonville, Inc. does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the Official AKC entry form for this event.

MASKS ARE REQUIRED FOR ALL PERSONS WHILE INSIDE THE BUILDING. While exhibiting in the ring, mask requirements are at the judges' discretion.

If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e., age division, color division, weight division.
- A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)
- Mixed Breed dogs entering classes for Agility, Obedience, and Rally trials should mark Breed as "All-American Dog/Mixed Breed." Sire and Dam information shall remain blank for mixed breed entrants.

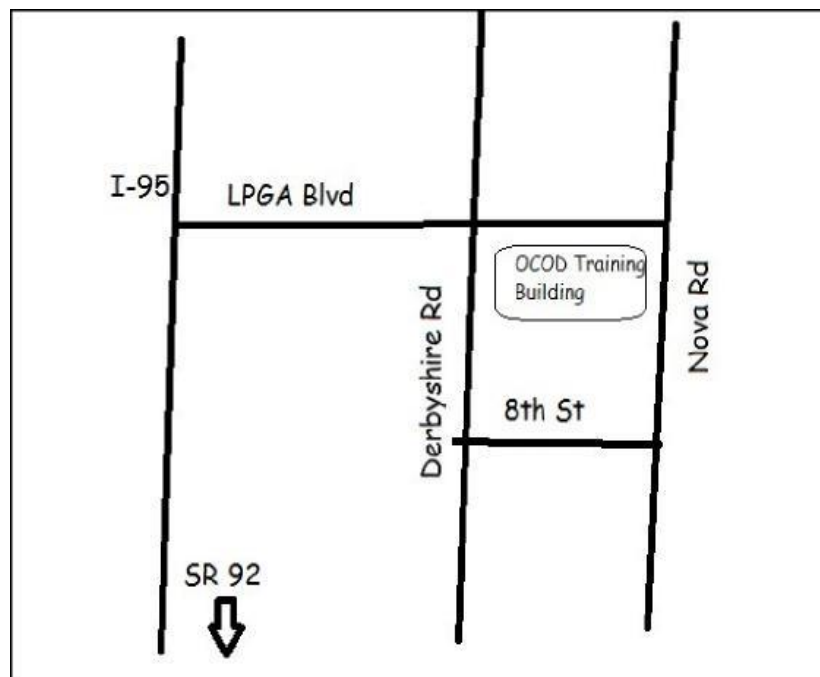

RANDOM REWARD CLASSES (BEGINNER NOVICE, NOVICE, OPEN, & UTILITY)

The RANDOM REWARD class is for any dog that can perform the exercises for the chosen class and that is eligible under the Obedience Regulations to compete in AKC events. No title is required to enter, and handlers may enter more than one dog. Dogs in this class may be handled by the owner or any other person and may be entered in another class or classes. The R/R class exercises will be performed as in the regular class, except that verbal praise during the exercises is to be encouraged and not penalized. "Good, yes, nice, super, great, atta boy" are some examples of praise that would be allowed. Handlers may give additional commands and encouragement without being penalized. Handlers will not be allowed to hold up a class with excessive encouragements and Judges will have the option to end any exercise.

Each handler may choose to

A) Skip one exercise or

B) Choose to do that exercise but the handler may now be allowed to leave position anywhere in that exercise, go toward the dog and reward with a toy. (Toys may not make noise or be an item that would roll into another ring).

When checking in, the handler must inform the judge or steward which exercise will be selected to skip or selected to go and reward the dog. The additional commands and encouragement without being penalized.

Handlers will not be allowed to hold up a class with excessive encouragements and Judges will have the option to end any exercise.

Each handler may choose to

A) Skip one exercise or

B) Choose to do that exercise but the handler may now, be allowed to leave position anywhere in that exercise, go toward the dog and reward with a toy. (Toys may not make noise or be an item that would roll into another ring).

When checking in, the handler must inform the judge or steward which exercise will be selected to skip or selected to go and reward the dog. The exercises will be performed in the same order as the regular Beginner Novice class.

*The R/R Beginner Novice class includes Rally signs which would aide Rally exhibitors preparing for the ring and would also be a great bridge class for the Rally exhibitor to then become an obedience exhibitor. Rally exhibitors are encourage to try this class!

The (R/R) Random Reward non regular classes will foster confidence for exhibitors and their dogs by allowing one reinforcement of a desired skill.

The Random Reward classes will be an entry point for juniors and new exhibitors to gain experience and confidence.

By offering Random Reward Classes, exhibitors will now be able to have ring experience praising and rewarding the dog (with a toy) in an actual AKC Obedience Ring."
