





K-9 Club By-Laws Revision in The Works

The K-9 Board of Governors, led by Christine Peterson, have spent the past year revising the K-9 Club By-Laws. The current Constitution and By-Laws are posted on the K-9 website. However, this version dates back to 2006 with spelling and grammar corrections made in 2020. Now, some necessary corrections and clarifications are due. Many of the revisions are in the wording and some inconsistencies were also found and corrected in references to related parts of the document. The corresponding and recording secretary are combined into one office. The revised document matches the practices of K-9 and doesn't change how the club will operate.

The benefits to K-9 in revising the By-Laws are several. First, the exercise provides an opportunity for all members to learn how K-9 is governed. If you haven't read the By-Laws before, doing so now will make you aware of how the club is structured and explain many details you June not have considered.

Second, revisions allow the streamlining and updating of procedures to match modern convenience.

Third, the revision being proposed by the Board of Governors adheres to a format that will position K-9 to apply for a 501c3 (nonprofit) tax designation. This has financial benefits such as tax relief and tax deductions to benefactors.

The vote to adopt the By-Laws revision will take place on June 15 at a special meeting to be held right before the Annual General Meeting from 5 to 7:30 pm. Please attend this very important Special By-Laws Meeting June 15 for the vote on the revision.

An email will be sent in the next few days to members with the revised By-Laws as well as a document to describe what changes have been made. The current By-laws are on the K-9 website. Please review these documents before the Special June Meeting. Remember only members up to date on dues will be able to vote.
